✠ ISOM Student's Testimonies ✠

Here is an update on what the Lord is doing

ISOM: On Feb. 1st we started our ISOM (International School of Ministry) diploma level studies. We have 69 students that are continuing on in their studies after completing certificate level classes. I would like to share with you a quick testimony from one of our students who has been changed by what they have learned in the classes.

The testimony is from **Thanduxolo Dlamini**. As long as Thanduxolo could remember (his mother told him since the age of 5 months) he had no hearing in his right ear, as well as a continual discharge of fluid. He is now in his mid 30's and has seen specialists in Swaziland and South Africa. The doctors told him that if he didn't have an operation, eventually the problem could affect his mind. After receiving the teaching on Supernatural Living and walking in divine health, he decided to trust God to heal his ear. During session 8 of the teaching he was supernaturally healed by God. His hearing was restored immediately. He went home and told his wife that the Lord healed his ear. She couldn't believe it! He still had a discharge coming from his ear, but he knew in his heart the Lord had healed him and continued to express faith, and speak faith filled words. Then one morning when he woke, the discharge was gone. He has since shared his testimony with others, who are also trusting in God for healing. We will be teaching soon at his church on growing in Christ.



Hospital Ministry

Yesterday we were at Children's Cup Global Leadership Academy (GLA) to teach on healing in preparation for our hospital ministry which starts today. RFM is one of the largest hospitals in Swaziland and we have been ministering there since March 2011.

The focus of the teaching was that the Lord is not only **willing** to heal (Matt 8:1-3) but he is also **able** to heal (Mark 9:20-27).

Today at hospital ministry, we saw the Lord once again do the **miraculous!** There was a woman in the maternity ward who could not speak or hear. We prayed for her and the Lord healed her and by the time we left she was able to say "good-bye!" Praise the Lord!
